About

I've had a passion for software development ever since I wrote my first program using BASIC, on a Commodore VIC 20, as a 12 year old in 1984.

My professional career started in 1995 and I have worked in various industries developing business software. I believe that software has to be useful and fit-for-purpose since there are probably going to be people using it for a good couple of hours a day, and one would like to avoid any frustrations.

I have ample knowledge with database design. However, I have moved to a more domain-driven approach and I consider a data store as simply that, and that no processing should be performed in a Database.

I do not really subscribe to any particular architectural style as I tend to think in terms of "concerns" and autonomous business components that can be deployed and versioned individually. This is what is largely now referred to as Microservices, where a bounded context represents that thinking quite nicely.

In order to ensure scalability and stability I have found messaging, along with a supporting event-driven architecture, to be quite useful.

I try to steer clear of vendor specific cloud technologies in favour of implementations that can be lift-shifted to any other platform. The most convenient approach is containerization.

Responsible for development on the C# back-end for an Android POS system which included Web-APIs and messaging endpoints. The solution made use of Azure Sql Server databases.

Also worked on the front-end portal that was written using React.

Notable Achievements:

- Introduced containerization by initially using Azure Container Apps, and then moving to Azure Kubernetes Service.
- Refactored classic DevOps pipelines to `yaml`.
- Involved in CRM integration performed by Azure Functions that had to be upgraded to isolated mode and subscribed to Azure Service Bus topics.
- Worked with a DevOps vendor to move our Azure resources from the "West Europe" region to "South Africa North". This transition was quite a smooth one and the ~11,000 devices continued functioning uninterrupted.
- Worked with an infrastructure vendor to investigate self-hosted options in order to move to a hybrid hosting model (Cloud/On-prem).
- Configured managed file transfer virtual machine to allow one of the large banks to send and receive lead management data.
- Worked with 2 FinTech companies (**ongoing at this time**) to implement soft-pay on our devices as well as marketing loans to tavern owners.
- When our Director of Technology left in February 2023 I was appointed as acting Director of Technology (System Architecture) from March 2023 to August 2023. Our managing director left the company at the end of August 2023 and a new organisational structure will be implemented by the new managing director.

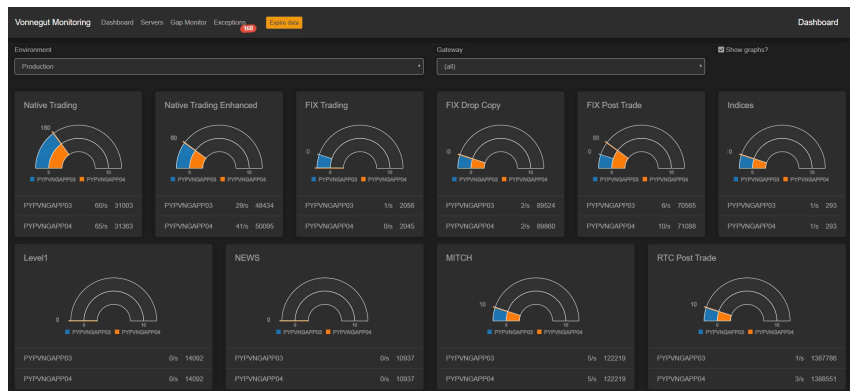
As a member of the monitoring team network packets (TCP/UDP) were captured and reported on. The TCP streams had to be built and, depending on the financial protocol used on the particular, messages would be decoded and serialized to a GZipped file.

Notable achievements:

Fixed TCP stream assembly that had been incorrectly implemented which subsequently required the reprocessing of messages since the system inception. This was roughly 3 years of data.

Removed redundant storage of empty buffer bytes on raw packets which resulted in a saving of about 50% disk space. The daily raw packet compressed files were gigabytes of data so that made a difference.

Implementation of monitoring / dashboard system (using a CanJS front-end, Sql Server data store, .Net Core web-api) for the relevant servers:



- Message throughput rates per second
- Network adapter availability through the WinPcap driver
- Data file creation to ensure correct system functioning

Refactored a gap monitor that subscribed to UDP packets and picked up gaps in the sequence. These gaps were integrated into the above-mentioned monitoring front-end.

In August 2019 I moved to the surveillance team where we have been using Azure DevOps since December 2019. I assisted the team in moving our source control over to Git.

Sebata / Developer

I started out contracting through EQ Plus / Atos to Sebata and then contracted directly to Sebata from 1 August 2016.

I was responsible for development on the billing module for an enterprise management system used by municipalities.

Notable achievements:

Implemented a domain model for the billing system and removed countless stored procedures. Introduced a messaging architecture on RabbitMQ using Shuttle.Esb and related components which enabled processing of any number of accounts where previously the system struggled to produce even a minimal set.

Demonstrated a single page application accessing a .Net Core web-api proof-of-concept running on Linux and had a minimal CanJS front-end to start a billing run. The back-end services were running as .Net Core console applications hosted on systemd as units. The database was still a Windows-based Sql Server running on the host.

Reason for leaving: Sebata moved to Centurion

Responsible for the development of the front-end framework that interacted with a webMethods back-end and I also fulfilled the role of team lead and stand-in scrum master from time-to-time.

Notable achievements:

Used node.js to host the static ember.js site locally on the user's machine which would automatically update itself when a new version was released.

Introduced messaging using Shuttle.Esb:

- In the front-end framework we used it to co-ordinate cached data changes among the load-balanced application servers.
- The CRM team had tremendous issues with notifications to the webMethods back-end and their implementation would hang every-so-often. The offending code had been replaced by a Shuttle.Esb component that simplified the implementation and immediately resolved the issue. This work was done by the CRM team.
- Shuttle.Esb was also implemented in the customer self-service side of things as well as in an Integration Framework for a third-party system. This work was done by the relevant team.

Reason for leaving: in the process of emigrating.

I was initially hired to assist in the redevelopment of existing PHP systems in C#. However, the business needs changed and I ended up working with PHP and MySQL.
